A complex and intriguing nose of lavender, violet, black pepper, paprika, dark berry fruit and hints of orange zest and dried herbs. The palate is firmly built with lots of tannin and acidity for great aging potential and the black and red currant, blackberry, raspberry, tobacco, earth and peppery spice linger on the long finish.
