Tasting Notes

A complex and elegant wine with red currant, cassis and mulberry fruit intertwined with interesting baking spice, burlap, orange zest, violet and balsamic reduction on the nose. The full bodied palate is very savoury with earth, dried sage and rosemary, black olive and paprika that opens up to blueberry and dried fig.
