The vines are nestled below a rock bluff providing a unique microclimate. Warm days and cool nights develop a wine that has an exotic nose of floral, peach, apricot, lemon and honeysuckle with a hint of baking spice. Full-bodied and rich on the palate with balancing fresh acidity and complex honey, ruby red grapefruit and orange peel combining with white peach and apricot on the long finish.
