An intense and lively wine with an aromatic nose of nectarine, lemon verbena, green apple and pear with complex chamomile and fresh basil notes. Dry, crisp and racy on the palate with concentrated pear, lemon zest, baking spice and peach skin with a long crisp, zesty finish.

30% of the Pinot Blanc was fermented in 2-3 year old French oak barrels for 5 months. The remainder of the Pinot Blanc and the Pinot Gris were fermented in stainless steel.
